- **DIVISION RESTRICTIONS:**
 - **Leadline**—8 years old & under. No cross entering.
 - **Walk**—10 years old & under. No cross entering.
 - **Walk-Trot**—10 years old & under. May only cross enter into Beginner English Rider, Mini-Stirrup, Novice Western Rider and Open Trail.
 - **Beginner English Rider W/T**—Any age. Rider's in first or second year of showing. May only cross enter into Walk-Trot, Mini-Stirrup, Long Stirrup, Novice Western Rider, and Open Trail, depending on age. Year-end champions are no longer eligible to compete in this division.
 - **Green Horse & Pony**—Horse or pony's first or second year of showing. Open to English & Western riders. Year-end champion horse or ponies are no longer eligible to compete in this division.
 - **Mini-Stirrup W/T/C**—13 years old & under. May only cross enter into Beginner English Rider, Novice Western Rider, Walk-Trot,* and Open Trail. ***IF** 10 years old & under.
 - **Long Stirrup W/T/C**—14 years old & over. May not cross-enter into Sr. Equitation or Working Equitation. Year-end champions are no longer eligible to compete in this division.
 - **Jr. Equitation W/T/C**—13 years old & under.
 - **Sr. Equitation W/T/C**—14 years old & over. May not cross enter into Working Equitation.
 - **Working Equitation W/T/C**—14 years old & over. May not cross enter into Sr. Equitation.
 - **Novice Western Rider W/J**—Any age. First or second year of showing. May only cross enter into Walk-Trot, Mini-Stirrup, Long Stirrup, Beginner English Rider and Open Trail, depending on age. Year-end champions are no longer eligible to compete in this division.
 - **Jr. & Sr. Working Versatility**—W/J/L, Back, Dismount and Ground Tie, optional Hand Gallop
 - **Jr. & Sr. Working Discipline Rail**—W/J/L, Back, optional Extended Gaits and Sidepass
 - **Trail**—Both English & Western may enter. Junior and Senior trail will run simultaneously. This class will be open 11am –2pm. Held in the lower ring behind the entry booth.

- **ENTRIES**—\$6.00 PER CLASS. There will be a \$4.00 ring fee per rider. Leadline riders excluded.
- **COGGINS**—All entries **must** present a current (one year) negative coggins at time of entry.
- SEI approved helmets with harness are **required** on **ALL** mounted riders under 18 years of age.
- All riders' ages are as of January 1 of the current year.
Juniors—13 years old & under as of 1/1. *Seniors*—14 years old & over as of 1/1.
- Audits should flip their numbers so that the number is upside down.
- Proper attire **must** be worn in all classes (unless excused by Judge).
- Six (6) ribbons will be awarded in all classes.
- All judges are qualified and carded.
- Champion & Reserve Champion will be awarded in all divisions.
- All points are awarded on **same** rider/mount combination. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- The points from all 5 shows will accumulate and series awards will be presented at our annual awards banquet. Our awards banquet will be held on January 23, 2010. We will begin to take reservations on October 4, 2009.
- No dogs allowed. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** No one allowed in barn area. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- No alcoholic beverages allowed. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- No smoking allowed. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- The show committee reserves the right to refuse entries or to change, combine or cancel classes with fewer than 4 entries. Anyone displaying poor sportsmanship will be asked to leave the grounds. **COACHING FROM SIDELINES IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.**
- Understanding that horse sports may be hazardous & dangerous, even leading to permanent injury or death, each owner, rider, spectator, and other participants assumes any AND all risk of loss or injury and agrees to hold harmless, regardless of negligent acts or omissions, the Linthicum 4-H Hi-Riders, A.E.C., the organizer, show committee, and all other personnel.

Directions

FROM NORTH & WEST: Take Balt. Beltway (695) to exit 8 (Nursery & Hammonds Ferry Rds.). Turn left at traffic light at end of ramp (Hammonds Ferry Road). At the 3rd traffic light, turn right (Andover Road). Andover Equestrian Center is on the left just past the school.

FROM EAST: Take Balt. Beltway (695) to exit 8 (Nursery & Hammonds Ferry Rds.). Bear right at top of exit, make a right at light onto Nursery Road. At next light make a left Hammonds Ferry Road. At 2nd traffic light turn right (Andover Road) Andover Equestrian Center is on the left just past the school.

FROM SOUTH: Take Rt. 97 (RT. 3) North to Dorsey Road. Turn right at end of ramp (Dorsey Road). Turn right onto Aviation Blvd. Turn right onto Andover Road. Go straight through 2 traffic lights. Andover Equestrian Center is on the left just past the school.
